We are on the whole an activist diocese. We had previously joined an ACLU lawsuit challenging the temporary immigration ban in 2017. That was an ongoing effort completed in the past year.

On the whole, we had refocused our energy more towards local action and equipping individuals with skills that would help them be better anti-racist ministers in the world.

We have developed specific Intercultural Competency tools because we believe that in the past, we have encouraged White Christians to engage in the conversation however they want. And that has really been damaging to Ministers of Color who are part of the conversation. We think that we can help White Christians with the remedial work of Intercultural Competency before asking them to do the harder work of Anti-Racism.

And we think if we don't have any provision for Intercultural Competency teaching and skill practice, the AR conversations would not be fruitful or lead to meaningful change.
